

Some of you may experience difficulty paging through images retrieved on our website. This is most likely due to a default internet browser setting on your computer. We have determined that QuickTime and Microsoft Office Picture Manager do not allow for paging down beyond the first page of an image on our system. To remedy this problem, you should change the default internet browser as follows: First, be certain your internet browser is closed and there is no active connection to the web. Then, click on Start, go to Settings, then Control Panel, then Folder Options, then click on the File Types tab. In the list that appears, scroll all the way down to TIF Files and click there. The list should expand to give you several program options to select from. We suggest you click either Microsoft Office Document Imaging or Windows Picture and Fax Viewer. Then click Close. Repeat the process for the next listed file type, TIFF Files. Then launch your internet browser. You should now be able to page down.
