

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: February 2, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” heard an overview from the director of the Madison County Emergency Management Agency regarding the January storms:
 - Shelters were used by dozens of people.
 - Three meals a day were prepared and offered to those in need.
 - More than 2,800 people were without electricity in Madison County. That number has decreased to approximately a dozen as of this morning.
- The Board announced a plan for a new conference center and hotel. The 50,000-square-foot facility will be built near Topgolf in Ridgeland. Gabriel Prado, the developer responsible for Topgolf, will develop a 250-room luxury hotel adjacent to the conference center.

The county hopes to begin construction in the summer of 2026. The next step is seeking approval for the project from the City of Ridgeland and the State of Mississippi.
- The Fleetcor Gas Docket was paid.
- The Board acknowledged the resignation of Calvin Garrett from the Valley View Fire Protection District.
- Regarding the Reunion Parkway Drainage Improvements, the Board accepted the 2025 Annual Report of the NPDES Phase II Stormwater Program for Madison County as prepared by Allen Engineering and Science.
- The Board approved a proposal from Headwaters, Inc. to complete the wetland/other waters assessment, Nationwide Permit, USFWS coordination, and a limited cultural resource desktop survey for roughly 1200 LF of an intermittent stream taking water from the Reunion Parkway Phase 2 project for the lump sum budget of \$19,000.
