

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: February 17, 2026

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” changed the zoning of land to I-2 at the request of Madison County Economic Development Authority.
- The Board approved advertising for the reconstruction of bridges on Old Canton Road over Little Bear Creek and Little Bear Creek Tributary.
- At the request of Supervisor Gerald Steen, the Board reappointed Neal Riley to the Citizen Services Board.
- The Board approved a Professional Services Agreement with Mississippi Engineering Group, Inc. for the Camden Wastewater Improvements Project for Conceptual Design Phase Services.
- The Board approved the final plat of Lewis Farms, Phase 2. The development is 81 lots on approximately 17.23 acres.
- The Board approved a resolution in support of the Build Alternative to accomplish the Weisenberger Road Improvements project.
- The Church of God Fountain of Life was granted tax exemption status.
