

The Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, April 18, 2022: Quick Notes

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, (the Board), voted today to abandon Swamp Road during a public hearing.
- The Board approved fire protection services contracts with the City of Canton and the South Madison County Fire Protection District for the purpose of protecting the Madison County Mega Site.
- The Board passed a resolution supporting a Leisure and Recreation District within Lake Caroline Subdivision.
- The Board approved hiring eight people to assist the Road Department during the summer months.
- Due to the completion of the Stump Road Bridge Project, the Board approved releasing the contractor, Beacon Construction LLC, from the project.
- The Board approved the preliminary plat for Martinique, Part 5.
- The Board voted to accept a revision to an agreement between Madison County and the Town of Flora for fire protection services.
- The Board hired Waggoner Engineering to manage the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project application process for a fee not to exceed \$150,000.
- The Board voted to renew an agreement between the Madison County School District and the Madison County Sheriff's Office to continue funding resource officers.
