Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: June 2, 2025

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, "the Board," received an update and acknowledged the plan for work to be done on the Madison County Historic Courthouse. The Historic Courthouse will have interactive kiosks that will focus on the arts, community, agriculture, religion, commerce, and education. The building will also have breakout rooms for community meetings.
- The Board approved a Resolution of Support for Entergy Mississippi to construct a 760-megawatt, natural gas-fired, electric generation facility, along with an associated substation, in the City of Ridgeland. The cost of the project is expected to reach \$1 billion.
- At the request of the City of Ridgeland, the Board approved funding to update microwave antennas and modems linking two MSWIN sites.
- At the request of Supervisor Karl M. Banks, the Board appointed Mary Mitchell Rushing to the West Madison Utility District Board.
- At the request of Supervisor Paul Griffin, the Board reappointed Dwight Luckett to the Madison County Economic Development Authority (MCEDA) Board.
- The Mississippi Association of Supervisors County Scholarships Program awarded scholarships to Jakierra Johnson of Canton and to R'Jay Jones of Canton.
- The Board accepted a donation of a bench for Rogers Park from Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.
- The Board granted tax exemption status for a parcel of land owned by The Mustard Seed.
- The Board approved the final plat of Lot 19 of Panther Creek.
