

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: July 7, 2025

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” acknowledged the 2025 land roll presented by Tax Assessor Norman Cannady. Madison County grew 3.5% from the 2024 land roll, bringing the true value of property in Madison County for 2025 to approximately \$16.225 billion with an assessed value of \$2.28 billion.
- The Board received two fire trucks. One will be assigned to the Farmhaven Fire Protection District, and the other will be assigned to the Southwest Fire Protection District.
- Mississippi Department of Transportation Executive Director Brad White addressed the Board regarding the \$150m needed to complete interstate widening from Madison to Gluckstadt. He advised that pre-construction should be completed by the end of the year and the project is a top priority.
- The County Administrator and the County’s subrecipients who received American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds provided an update on the projects that were funded. Madison County received approximately \$20.6m.
- The Board approved construction on Loring Road from Highway 51 to Stump Bridge Road.
- The Board approved construction on Pear Orchard Road from County Line Road to Northpark Drive.
- Capitol Resources, Madison County’s state lobbying firm, advised the Board that the state legislature approved funding for three additional assistant district attorneys.
- At the request of Supervisor Paul Griffin, the Board appointed Billy Joe Wells to the Madison County Historical Courthouse Committee.
- Catholic Charities, Inc., received a personal property tax exemption.
- At the request of the Election Commission, the Board approved Liberty M.B. Church, located at 815 West Fulton Street in Canton, as a voting precinct for primary and general elections.
- The Board approved the final plat of Woodgate, Phase 1B. The development is 35 lots on approximately 17.11 acres.
- The Board approved the preliminary plat for Bainbridge Phase IV.
