

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: October 20, 2025

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” received a quarterly update from engineers working on the following capacity improvement projects in Madison County:
 - Calhoun Station Parkway (Stantec)
 - Stribling Road from Highway 463 to Dewees Road (Garver Engineering)
 - Stribling Road from Dewees Road to Catlett Road (Michael Baker Engineering)
 - Weisenberger Road (Neel-Schaffer Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Highway 51 to Smith-Carr Road (Waggoner Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Smith-Carr Road to North Old Canton Road (Waggoner Engineering)
 - Intersection of North Old Canton Road and Yandell Road (Benchmark)
 - Yandell Road from North Old Canton Road to Bainbridge Crossing (Pickering Engineering)
 - Yandell Road from Bainbridge Crossing to Highway 43 (Pickering Engineering)
 - Status on Wheatley Street: Hemphill Construction was the lowest bidder. Work on reconstruction and pedestrian improvements is scheduled to be completed within the next nine months.
 - Status on Bozeman Road: During the next year, traffic will be swapped to the new lanes, and the older lanes will be used at that time to finish the project.

- At the request of Supervisor Casey Brannon, Neil Godfrey, Michael Heard, Cliff Decker, and Jim Moore were appointed to the Lost Rabbit URD Board.
- Regarding the Calhoun Station Reconstruction Project, the Board approved and awarded the contract to the lowest bidder, Hemphill Construction Company, Inc. for \$7,422,800.
- The Board approved the final plat for White Oak Farms, Phase 1.

- The Board approved the final plat for Millbridge 1 A of Caroline.
- The Board acknowledged an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the City of Canton for tax assessment and collection.
- The Board acknowledged a request from the Circuit Court for 10% of future Opioid Settlement Funds, approximately \$22,000.
- The Board authorized readvertising for renovations and improvements to the technological capabilities in the boardroom.
