

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: December 1, 2025

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, "the Board," approved a request from the City of Canton to use E-911 funds in the amount of \$196,500 to modernize and restore their tornado warning system.
- The County Administrator advised the Board that phase 1(Northeast Madison County) of the broadband project has been completed, and residents can now contact Comcast either via www.Xfinity.com/mytown or the Xfinity store in Ridgeland for their high-speed internet needs.
- At the Request of Supervisor Karl M. Banks, the Board approved the appointment of Percy Brooks to the Madison County Economic Development Authority Board.
- The Board approved using \$33,817.60. in E-911 funds for a complete replacement of the public address (PA) system in all Ridgeland Fire Department stations. The upgrade will address issues with clarity and reliability during emergency call tones and will also support their implementation of a new, modernized toning system.
- The Board approved a Supplemental Agreement with Waggoner Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$604,071.32 for right-of-way acquisition for widening Yandell Rd. from North Old Canton Rd. to Smith-Carr Rd.
- The Board approved an additional Supplemental Agreement with Waggoner Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$585,860.28 for right-of-way acquisition related to widening Yandell Rd. from Smith-Carr Rd. to Highway 51.
- The Board approved a plat amendment for Cedar Point Subdivision.
