

The Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting: August 1, 2022: Quick Notes

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, (the Board), entered into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Board and the Mississippi Department of Transportation regarding widening Yandell Road from Westfalen to Madison Crossing Elementary School. The project is expected to start in 2025.
- The Board awarded a contract to Great Southern Recreation for playground equipment at Sulphur Springs Park for \$614,800.
- The Board approved a resolution between Madison County and the Madison County Nursing Home to accept grant money to pay for the playground equipment at Sulphur Springs Park.
- The Board acknowledged a letter from the Honorable Michael Watson, Secretary of State, outlining Madison County's share of the Mississippi Voting Modernization Act Grant Program. Madison County's pro rata share is \$212,436.13.
- The Board approved the site plan for a classroom at Holy Trinity Church.
- The Board approved the renewal of the contract with Guardian Insurance Company for county employees' dental, vision, and life insurance.
- The Board approved the renewal of the contract with UMR for the county employees' medical insurance.
- The Board approved advertising a public hearing for the FY 2023 Budget and Tax Levy on September 5, 2022.

The Madison County Board of Supervisors will meet again Monday, August 15th at 9:00 a.m. in the Administrative Building in Canton.
