

“You may have recently received a postcard from the U. S. District Court about completing a juror questionnaire. While this is legitimate and not a scam, it is not from our court or from Madison County. It is from the federal court, headquartered in Jackson. The postcard did not contain the correct 9-digit juror participant number on the front. This was an error by their printer, and another postcard will be sent to you by U. S. Mail this week containing the correct participant number. You can use this number to login to the online form (at the website on the back of the new postcard) and complete the questionnaire. Or, you may simply wait on the paper copy of the questionnaire to arrive by U. S. Mail in the next few weeks and fill it out and send it in then.

You will have additional time to complete the online questionnaire once you receive the new postcard. We have been in touch with the U. S. District Court and they apologize for the confusion the first postcard caused. Be on the lookout for the new postcard that will be correct.”
