

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: July 1, 2024

- Madison County Tax Assessor Norman Cannady presented the 2024 Real and Personal Property Tax Rolls showing 3.4% growth from the prior year.
- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” approved a request from the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) to establish a Long-Term Disaster Committee, made up of appointed individuals from each supervisor’s district, to provide possible financial assistance for building supplies for non-declared disasters. Each non-declared disaster could receive up to \$250,000 in total assistance funds.
- The Board granted two tax exemptions for parcels of land owned by the First Church of Canton.
- At the request of the Madison County Historic Courthouse Committee, the Board approved the concept of utilizing the historic courthouse as a learning center. The learning center can be used by organizations, schools, etc. to hold meetings and will include kiosks and other exhibits to tell the history of Madison County.
- The Board approved boundaries for a new Deerfield Precinct. The Madison County Circuit Clerk will let voters know if they are impacted.
- The Board approved a Cooperative Agreement between the County and the City of Flora to spend unused funds from a prior agreement to pave Monroe Street.
- The Board approved a Cooperation Agreement between the County and the City of Gluckstadt regarding the County patching, paving and continuing maintenance of a portion of Stout Road lying within the municipal limits of Gluckstadt.
- The Board approved the preliminary plat of a Subdivision of Lot 23A, Panther Creek (An Unrecorded Subdivision). The development is 3 lots on approximately 18.02 acres.
- The Board approved a Preliminary Plat for Westpointe Phases 1 and 2.
- The Board approved a Preliminary Plat for Mission Park Phase 1.
- Based on a request from the Farmhaven Fire Protection District Board, the Board of Supervisors approved a Resolution of Intent to Levy a 2 Mill increase to operate the Farmhaven Fire Protection District.
