

Quick Notes from the Board of Supervisors Meeting: September 3, 2019

- The Board passed the 2020 budget, which is based on 2.5% growth. The budget calls for \$122.5 mm in income and \$121.8 mm in expenses.
- The Board approved issuing TIF bonds for the Villages of Madison. The entire development will be 18.5 acres. Approximately 10 acres of that will be commercial, with restaurants, retail and office space. It will be located off Main Street near the police department.
- \$170,000 was allocated for work to be done on Virililia Road.
- Highland Chapel Hill will no longer be a voting precinct. However, the election commission presented, and the Board approved, Parkway Pentecostal Church as the new precinct. Cards will be mailed to voters prior to the November general election to advise of the new polling location.
- \$8,840 was allocated for work to be done on Miller Street.

The Madison County Board of Supervisors is scheduled to meet on September 16, 2019, at 5:00 pm in the Administrative Building in Canton. A full agenda and back-up information will be placed on our website prior to the meeting.
